# Cleaning

#### Upholstery

Wash your upholstery weekly with a mild liquid soap and water mixture, rinse with clear water and dry completely to remove disinfection cleaner buildup.

Disinfect your upholstery with a solution of standard bleach and water mixed 1 in 10 (10%) or chlorine based cleaners (see current CDC Guideline for Disinfection and Sterilization in Healthcare Facilities). Follow this with a clear water rinse and thorough drying of material.

To minimize damage caused by disinfectant cleaner residue buildup, do not allow disinfectants to pool on the upholstery surface. Once the approved contact time has been obtained, remove and dry excess liquid remaining on the surface.

#### Painted Metal / Plastic Surfaces

Clean the painted metal and plastic surfaces weekly using a clean soft cloth and mild cleaner.

# To operate the Base / Back / Tilt functions...

Press and hold the appropriate button.

Example: The Base Up button is called out in the illustration.

# **Programming Chair Positions** (647 programmable models only)

This feature allows you to easily recall frequently used chair positions.

#### To program a chair position...

- A. Move chair to desired position.
- B. Press the Program button. [single "beep"]
- C. Press the desired Position button (1, 2, 3 or 4). [three "beeps"] (Tip: You must press the Position button within 5 seconds)


# To recall a programmed position...

Press and hold the desired Position button (1, 2, 3 or 4).



#### Attention

To Stop movement of any automatic chair function: Press the Stop button on the touch pad or foot control.




#### **QuickChair Function**

This function activates the Back Down, Tilt Down and Base Down (647 only) functions simultaneously.

#### To activate the QuickChair function...

Press and hold the QuickChair button.




**Note:** The 3-function, programmable controls are shown. The applicable symbols used on the 2-function non-programmable controls are the same.

**QuickExam®** Function (647 non-programmable models only) This function positions the chair for an exam by activating the Base Up and Tilt Up functions simultaneously.

#### To activate the QuickExam function...

- A. Press and hold the QuickExam button.
- B. Release button when chair reaches desired position.
